4. City Budget Study Session

The City Manager stated that the Budget operationalizes the deep cuts that were made after the elimination of the Redevelopment Agency. This budget is different from past years in that it focuses on the big picture. It does not include any fee increases. The City Manager recommended that the Mayor designate a Council Subcommittee on Capital Improvement Projects as well as a Subcommittee on Economic Development Strategy.


Jose Gomez recapped the Proposed Budget which included a \$2.6 million deficit.


5. ADJOURNMENT
