

**MINUTES  
REGULAR TRAFFIC COMMISSION MEETING  
CITY OF SANTA FE SPRINGS  
JANUARY 15, 2015**

**1. CALL TO ORDER**

Commissioner Radoumis called the Traffic Commission meeting to order at 6:08 PM.

**2. ROLL CALL**

Present: Commissioners Martinez; Moore, and Radoumis

Absent: Chairperson Berg (excused); Vice Chairperson AJ Hayes (excused)

**3. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE AUDIENCE**

Commissioner Radoumis announced that this is the time when comments may be made by interested persons on matters not on the agenda having to do with City traffic related business and acknowledged Mayor Pro Tem Laurie Rios and Public Works Director Noe Negrete in the audience. **5. Traffic Bureau Report – December 2014**

Mr. Lopez reviewed the Traffic Bureau Report for the month of December 2014. The report reflects 57 collisions, which is a decrease of one (1) compared to 58 collisions in December 2013. There was one (1) collisions involving person driving under the influence of alcohol/drugs; one (1) pedestrian and one (1) bicycle collision. There were sixteen (16) hit-and-run collisions and six (6) collisions involving damage to city property reported. The three high collision intersections for the month were Telegraph Road / Painter Avenue (3); Telegraph Road / Shoemaker Avenue (2) and Alondra Boulevard / Freeway Drive (1).

Commissioner Martinez inquired on the breakdown of citations issued for motorists without a driver's license or without insurance and requested to have the statistics for age of unlicensed drivers.

Mr. Lopez indicated that citation statistics for motorists driving without a driver's license will be added to the City's collision database beginning in January 2015. He will check to see if the age of the unlicensed drivers is something that can be captured.

Commissioner Moore made a motion to receive and file the report for Item 05; the motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and was approved by the Traffic Commission as follows: In Favor: Radoumis, Martinez and Moore; Opposed: None; Absent: Berg, Hayes.

**6. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Commissioner More made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected; Commissioner Martinez seconded the motion and was approved by the Traffic Commission as follows: In Favor: Radoumis, Martinez and Moore; Opposed: None. Absent: Berg, Hayes.

Mr. Lopez provided information on the upcoming Traffic Commissioners Workshop that is scheduled for March 14, 2015 and encouraged their attendance. He also provided a brief presentation on National Street Safety from an article in AARP on "Perilous Crossings" noting that, in the United States, every 2 hours a pedestrian dies in a traffic collision and that the survival rate correlates to the speed of vehicle.
