

**MINUTES  
REGULAR TRAFFIC COMMISSION MEETING  
CITY OF SANTA FE SPRINGS  
AUGUST 20, 2015**

**1. CALL TO ORDER**

Commissioner Berg called the Traffic Commission meeting to order at 6:10 p.m.

**4. Traffic Bureau Report – July 2015**

Mr. Tom Lopez reviewed the Traffic Bureau Report for the month of July 2015. The report reflects 52 collisions, which is an increase of five (5) compared to 47 in July 2014. There were three (3) collisions involving person driving under the influence of alcohol/drugs; zero (0) pedestrians and one (1) bicycle collision. There were eighteen (18) hit-and-run collisions and three (3) collisions involving damage to city property reported. The three high collision intersections for the month were Valley View Avenue/Firestone Boulevard (3); Bloomfield Avenue/Florence Avenue (3) and Sorensen Avenue/Slauson Avenue (3).

Commissioner Radoumis made a motion to receive and file the report for Item 04; the motion was seconded by Commissioner Moore and was approved by the Traffic Commission as follows:


Commissioner Moore indicated that she will not be attending the meeting in September, but prefers 3:30 PM as the time to begin the tour.


Mr. Lopez provided updates for the following items brought up at the previous meeting:

- Terminix Issues – Luis Collazo of Code enforcement spoke to some of the residents along Smith Avenue, however, no one had any issues with loud noises late at night or Terminix employees parking in front of their homes. He suggested that they contact Mr. Collazo when they hear the loud noises.
- Orr and Day Road Permit Parking - Mr. Lopez indicated the Police Services has not received a request for parking permits in the past three years, but permits are available upon request from the Police Services Center.
- Signage on Fallon Avenue – there was a 10 MPH sign missing below the curve warning sign, but it had been ordered and should be installed by now.
- Green light at Norwalk/Lakeland Road – City of Norwalk maintains these signals. They were contacted and have since replaced the green lights that were partially burned out.
