

**MINUTES  
REGULAR TRAFFIC COMMISSION MEETING  
CITY OF SANTA FE SPRINGS  
JANUARY 21, 2016**

**1. CALL TO ORDER**

Chairperson Hayes called the Traffic Commission meeting to order at 6:02 PM.

Chairperson Hayes announced that this is the time when comments may be made by interested persons on matters not on the agenda having to do with City traffic related business. There being no one person to address the Commission, Oral Communications were closed at 6:03 PM.

**4. Traffic Bureau Report – December 2015**

Mr. Lopez reviewed the Traffic Bureau Report for the month of December 2016. The report reflects 69 collisions, which is an increase of twelve (12) compared to 57 in December 2014. There were seven (7) collisions involving person driving under the influence of alcohol/drugs; one (1) pedestrian and no bicycle collisions. There were nine (9) hit-and-run collisions and fifteen (15) collisions involving damage to city property reported. The three high collision intersections for the month were Orr and Day Road/Telegraph Road (3); Bloomfield Avenue/Lakeland Avenue (3) and Florence Avenue/Shoemaker Avenue (3).

Vice Chair Martinez made a motion to receive and file the report for Item 05; the motion was seconded by Commissioner Radoumis and was approved by the Traffic Commission as follows:

Chairperson Hayes noted that at the 4-way stop sign controlled intersection of Jersey Avenue and Pioneer Boulevard requires traffic monitoring. He indicated when he crosses here daily about 11:00 am and some vehicles do not stop. Officer Igros indicated that he will make himself available to do traffic enforcement at that intersection.



**Staff**

Mr. Lopez shared a presentation commemorating the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the nation's first freeway. The Arroyo Seco Parkway or as it is better known today – the Pasadena Freeway, which connected Downtown Pasadena to Downtown Los Angeles. It is a National Civil Engineering Landmark, a National Scenic Byway, and the first of just two California Historic Parkways (the other being State route 163 through Balboa Park in San Diego).
