

**MINUTES
SPECIAL TRAFFIC COMMISSION MEETING
CITY OF SANTA FE SPRINGS
JUNE 14, 2016**

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Radoumis called the Traffic Commission meeting to order at 6:04 PM.

2. ROLL CALL

3. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE AUDIENCE

Chairperson Radoumis announced that this is the time when comments may be made by interested persons on matters not on the agenda having to do with City traffic related business. Ms. Annette Rodriguez, President of the Santa Fe Springs Women's Club's provided information on the upcoming 14th Annual Scholarship Fundraiser set for Sunday August 7, 2016 from 11:00 am to 3 pm. There being no other person to address the Commission, Oral Communications were closed at 6:07 PM.

4. Traffic Bureau Report – May 2016

Mr. Lopez reviewed the Traffic Bureau Report for the month of May 2016. The report reflects a revised total of 58 collisions, which is an increase of two (2) compared to fifty-six in May 2015. There were five (5) collisions involving person driving under the influence of alcohol/drugs; no (0) pedestrians and one (1) bicycle collision. There were sixteen (16) hit-and-run collisions and three (3) collisions involving damage to city property reported. There were no intersections with multiple collisions during May 2016.

Vice-Chairperson Hayes made a motion to receive and file Item 4; the motion was seconded by Commissioner Martinez and was approved by the Traffic Commission as follows:

5. 2015 Top Ten Intersections for Collision Frequency

Mr. Lopez presented Item 05 and provided detailed information based on a review of the City's collision database to determine the ten intersections having the highest

number of collisions for the 2015 calendar year. He noted that Telegraph/Carmenita Road; Telegraph/Bartley-605 Freeway On-Ramp; Bloomfield/Lakeland Road and Telegraph/Norwalk Boulevard were not included on the Top Ten List for 2014.
