

**MINUTES  
ADJOURNED TRAFFIC COMMISSION MEETING  
CITY OF SANTA FE SPRINGS  
OCTOBER 18, 2016**

**1. CALL TO ORDER**

Chairperson Radoumis called the Traffic Commission meeting to order at 6:05 PM.

Chairperson Radoumis announced that this is the time when comments may be made by interested persons on matters not on the agenda having to do with City traffic related business. There being no one person to address the Commission, Oral Communications were closed at 6:06 PM.

**4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Commissioner Martinez made a motion to approve and file the minutes for September 15, 2016; the motion was seconded by Vice Chair Hayes and was approved by the Traffic Commission as follows:

**5. COMMUNICATIONS**

**Commission**

Commissioner Martinez asked if the red curbs around the City are painted based on a schedule. Mr. Lopez explained that the curbs around the schools are painted in the summer, prior to the beginning school year and other curbs are repainted based on requests made.

Commissioner Martinez requested clarification on parking signs denoting "No Stopping Any Time" with an arrow pointed in one direction and has adjacent red curb that extends in the opposite direction. Mr. Lopez indicated that the red curb is an extension of the parking restriction and the beginning of the red curb is the beginning of the restriction.

Vice Chair Hayes wished everyone a safe and happy Halloween.

Chairperson Radoumis inquired on the status of the parking restrictions that were approved by the Commission on September 15, 2016. Mr. Lopez indicated that the items were being presented to Council at their adjourned meeting on October 20, 2016 and would go in effect as soon as the parking restriction signs are received.

**Staff**

Mr. Lopez provided updates on the following items:

- Valley View Avenue/Alondra Boulevard Ground Breaking Ceremony is scheduled for October 26, 2016 at 2:00 pm. Noted they are welcomed to attend, however, City transportation will not be provided.
- Parkmead Street Improvement project began Monday, October 17, 2016. This project is scheduled to be completed by middle of December 2016. Eleven bids were received and the engineer's estimate was \$500,000 and the low bid \$416,403. He indicated that the pine trees removed along the street were the major culprits that damaged the street, sidewalk and curb and gutter. Once the street is repaved, new parkway trees will be replanted.
- Bartley Avenue Street Improvement project is scheduled to begin next week. This project is scheduled to be completed by late December 2016. The project was awarded to the low bidder for \$456,447. The engineer's estimate was \$615,500.
- As of right now, there is no confirmed date from Caltrans for the Florence Avenue partial bridge closure which will reduce Florence Avenue to one lane each direction.
- There will be a community meeting held at the end of November to provide an update to the residents of the I-5 Freeway/Florence Avenue project.
- The Parkette Improvement Project for Bradwell, Longworth and Davenrich locations is 35% complete and is scheduled be completed by early November 2016.
